The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SWk SWk), Section 12, T. 39 S., R. 10 E., W. M., 450 feet North and 450 feet East from SE Corner, Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.2 acres SWk SEk 9.2 acres SEk SEk Section 2

6.7 acres NW% NE% Section 11 T. 39 S., R. 10 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 18, 1965, and together with the certificate recorded in Volume 24 at page 32381 supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to George E. Stevenson and recorded at page 27619, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
