that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring \$1, 0.02 cubic foot per second from spring \$2, 0.02 cubic foot per second from spring \$3 and 0.05 cubic foot per second from East Fork Wallows River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA SEA, SEA SEA, Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 45 E., W. M., Spring #1 - 3160 feet South and 120 feet West; Spring #2 - 3140 feet South and 60 feet West; Spring #3 - 3040 feet South and 220 feet East; East *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
