**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** **V. A. SEARLES and RALPH D. WATSON**  
**UPPER WALLOWA LAKE WATER DISTRICT**

of **Joseph**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
**three springs and East Fork Wallowa River**

a tributary of **Wallowa River** for the purpose of  
**group domestic**

under Permit No. **29353** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from **December 30, 1963**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
**0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring #1,  
0.02 cubic foot per second from spring #2, 0.02 cubic foot per second from spring  
#3 and 0.05 cubic foot per second from East Fork Wallowa River**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the **SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 29, T. 3 S., R. 45 E.,  
W. M.**; Spring #1 - 3160 feet South and 120 feet West; Spring #2 - 3140 feet  
South and 60 feet West; Spring #3 - 3040 feet South and 220 feet East; East \*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

use herein described.
