**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That CHARLES O. and DOROTHY B. NEWTON**

of Sitkum Route, Box 169, Myrtle Point, State of <sup>97458</sup> Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Coquille River and spring

a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation of 9.2 acres and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 29517 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 5, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.125 cubic foot per second being 0.12 cubic foot per second for irrigation from river and 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic from spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 35, T. 28 S., R. 12 W., W. M., 910 feet North and 520 feet East, spring - 220 feet North and 630 feet West; both from SW Corner, Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.9 acres Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
domestic and 0.3 acre Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 35  
T. 28 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
