CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **ALDO U. & ROSE MARCA**

of **Route 1, Box 4090, Coquille**, State of **Oregon** ⁹⁷⁴²³, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring and Fat Elk Creek

a tributary of **Coquille River** for the purpose of domestic use of one family, irrigation of 45.2 acres, use in a dairy barn, and stock under Permit No. **31723** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 13, 1966** for 0.58 cubic foot per second, **February 3, 1967** for 0.01 cubic foot per second from spring for stock and use in a dairy barn

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic, 0.01 cubic foot per second for stock and use in a dairy barn from spring, and 0.57 cubic foot per second for irrigation from Fat Elk Creek.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 28 S., R. 13 W., W. M., Spring - 1690 feet South and 2010 feet West, Fat Elk Creek - 2640 feet South and 800 feet East and 2230 feet South, all from *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic, Stock, Use in a dairy barn, and 0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
