CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE HAWKINS

of Route 1, Box 430-F, Bandon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Johnson Creek and reservoir constructed under Application number R-43421, Permit number R-4984

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of frost control, irrigation and cranberry harvesting of 3.96 acres

under Permit No. 32463 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 28, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second, being 0.59 cubic foot per second for frost control, 0.10 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.59 cubic foot per second for cranberry harvesting

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Cr.-SE\ SE\, Section 5; Res.-SW\ NE\, Section 8, T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M., Cr.-2780 feet North and 1150 feet West; Res.-720 feet North and 1750 feet West, both from E\ Corner, Section 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-4984 for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year* and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.96 acres SWk NEk Section 8 T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

*from direct flow and storage from reservoir,

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
