for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-5045 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed date from August 16, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.83 cubic foot per recond

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX, Section 28, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W. M., Well located: 1300 feet South and 1320 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the completed well shall not exceed 200 feet nor appropriate water from an aquifer below the depth of the alluvial gravels,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NEX NWX
32.4 acres NWX NWX
33.2 acres SWX NWX
0.4 acre SEX NWX
0.2 acre NWX SWX

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
