under Permit No. G-4785 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 5, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.26** cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in care of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEZ NWZ, as projected with Richardson DLC 47, Section 19, T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 160 feet North and 1900 Feet East from the SE Corner, Lot 1, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre NWk NEk
0.9 acre SWk NEk
13.6 acres NEk NWk
6.0 acres SEk NWk
All as projected within Richardson DLC 47
Section 19
T. 5 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
