a tributary of South Umpqua River irrigation of 14.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 8227 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 2, 1927

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located, in the SW\$ NE\$, Section 34; SE\$ SW\$, NE\$ SW\$, NW\$ SW\$, Section 27, T. 31 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.4 acres SWk NWk 6.5 acres NWk SWk Section 27

4.0 acres SWt NEt Section 34 T. 31 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Oscar Head and recorded at page 37361, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 54.2 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 39.3 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered June 8, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Oscar Hezd.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
