CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. N. LARIMORE

of Williams, State of Oregon 97544, has a right
to the use of the waters of West Fork of Williams Creek

a tributary of Williams Creek (Applegate River) for the purpose of
irrigation of 0.81 acres
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.
Diversion point located: 75 feet North and 350 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 7.
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

0.81 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to J. N. Larimore and recorded at page 33247,
Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use
of water for irrigation of 12.0 acres. A change in the point of diversion for the
irrigation of 11.19 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered July 9,
1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water
for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to J. N. Larimore.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
