CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Route 2, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 23.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 14595 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 15, 1940 for 0.25 cubic foot per second, and September 13, 1940 for 0.05 cubic foot per second

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWk SEk, as projected within Chas. Conklin DLC 53, Section 18, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.; 2046 feet North and 2244 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.3 acres NWk SEk
12.2 acres SWk SEk
6.2 acres SEk SWk
3.0 acres NEk SWk
All as projected within Chas. Conklin DLC 53
Section 18
T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

Certificate of later right issued to Albert J. Evers and recorded at page 17028, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 51.1 acres. A change in place of use and point of diversion for the irrigation of 27.4 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered June 25, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Albert J. Evers.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
