## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That 1. J. HEESACKER

of Route 1, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek

Dairy Creek a tributary of irrigation of 94.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 13388 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 19, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.175 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW SW. Section 12, 2 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., as projected within John Lousignout DLC 52.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 3.3 acres NEt SWt

26.0 acres NEt SEt

37.7 acres NWt SEt 14.0 acres SWt SEt

11.0 acres SEt SEt

All as projected within John Lousignout DLC 52 Section 11

2.0 acres NWt SWt As projected within John Lousignout DLC 52 Section 12 T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered March 27, 1973, approves a change in place of use for the irrigation of 30.0 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to L. J. Heesacker and recorded at page 14207, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
