CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 1584 W. Main, Sheridan , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork of Yamhill River

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 2.8 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22850 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1954

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.035 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SE% NE%), Section 33, T. 5 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 50 feet South and 115 feet East from the Westerly SW Corner, Graves DLC, 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to John R. Umfred and recorded at page 26233, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 11.8 acres. A change in the point of diversion for the irrigation of 9.0 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered May 4, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John R. Umfred.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
