## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 525 West 18th Place, McMinnville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Yamhill River

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 20 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 25607 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk NWk, as projected within H. Martin DLC 37, Section 5, T. 5 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres SWt NWt
1.5 acres SEt NWt
3.1 acres NEt SWt
10.4 acres NWt SWt
All as projected within W. Garrison DLC 40
Section 5
T. 5 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to M. Swartzentruber and recorded at page 28153, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 20.0 acres. A change in the place of use of water for the irrigation of 4.6 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered July 9, 1973. This certificate is issued to confirm the change in place of use and the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to M. Swartzentruber.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesail is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
