CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Box 80 B, Arago Route, Myrtle Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Coquille River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 27.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32536 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 17, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.34 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW4 SE4 as projected within Hall DLC 38, Section 36,
T. 28 S., R. 13 W., W. M., 1920 feet North and 1050 feet East from SW Corner, Hall
DLC 38.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each is irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each fear,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
