, State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Conners' Creek and reservoir constructed under Application number R-43654, Permit number R-5014

a tributary of Davis Creek for the purpose of

irrigation and frost control of 5.6 acres

under Permit No. 32634 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby May 26, 1967 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second being 0.14 cubic foot per second for irrigation, 0.22 cubic foot per second for frost control

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX SWX, Section 12, T. 30 S., R. 15 W., W. M., Creek located: 260 feet North and 450 feet West; Reservoir located: 860 feet North and 320 feet West, both from the St Corner, Section 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5014 for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year* and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed : R-5014

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
