CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That elmer A. GANT & GRACE E. GANT

of Box 156, Bandon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Johnson Creek and two reservoirs constructed under application number R-45812 permit number R-5432

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 2.3 acres, supplemental irrigation of 7.6 acres, frost control and cranberry harvesting of 7.6 acres

under Permit No. 34186 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.14 cubic feet per second, being 1.14 cubic feet per second for frost control from Johnson Creek, 0.06 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.38 cubic foot per second for cranberry harvesting from Johnson Creek and reservoirs and 1.05 acre feet*

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Creek: SWk SWk, Section 5; Reservoir #1: NWk NWk;

Reservoir #2: NEk NWk, Section 8, T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M., Creek: 30 feet North
and 1190 feet East; Reservoir #1: 1240 feet South and 650 feet East; Reservoir #2:**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under permit number R-5432 for cramberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from*** and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

*** direct flow and storage from reservoirs constructed under permit number R-5432 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same lands and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as supplemental.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
