CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That F. O. ANDERSON,

of Haines, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Rock Creek, a tributary of Powder River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 196 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 1887 for Tract No. 1, and April, 1891 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 38 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 38 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter, and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-one, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian;

Tract No. 2: 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter, and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Seven South, Range Thirty-eight East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
