CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAROLD 0. and MARIE RAND

of Box 211 C., Idleyld Route, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River domestic use of one family and irrigation of 6.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33724 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.085 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.075 cubic foot per second for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (SEX NWX), Section 15, T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 3230 feet North and 10 feet West from SX Corner, Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such sonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.9 acres Lot 6 (SEt NWt)
Domestic and 4.1 acres NEt SWt
Section 15
T. 26 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
