under Permit No. 35586 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 11. 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.01 cubic foot per second for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NEX NWX, as projected within Dixon DLC 41, Section 26, T. 26 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 140 feet South and 150 feet West from the SE Corner, Lot 12 Echo Bend Estates.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
