CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CARL F. WERNER**

97026

of **Route 1, Box 250-A, Gervais**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **two wells**

a tributary of **Champoeg Creek** for the purpose of irrigation of **127.4 acres**

under Permit No. **G-3682** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 9, 1967**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **1.45 cubic feet per second, being 1.10 cubic feet per second from Well No. 1 and 0.35 cubic foot per second from Well No. 2**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Bihan DLC 89, Section 21, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected within **Bihan DLC 89, Section 28, T. 5 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Well No. 1 - 300 feet South and 2060 feet West, Well No. 2 - 260 feet North and ***

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
