CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That J. P. ATWOOD

of Baker, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Sutton Creek, a tributary of Powder River and Powder River, a tributary of Snake River
for the purpose of stock, sub-irrigation and the irrigation of 70 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 1893 for stock purposes; 1908 for the sub-irrigation of 5 acres; 1904 for the irrigation of 20 acres and 1908 for the irrigation of 50 acres of land.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $\frac{1}{40}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: The place of use for stock purposes is in the South half of Northeast quarter and East half of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-eight, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian.

Sub-irrigation of 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-one, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian.

The irrigation of 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 30 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Ten, Township Nine South, Range Forty East of Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
