CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EUGENE RICCO

of Prairie City , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 117.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2892 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.46 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to Wm. J. Galbraith and recorded at page 3288, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 160.0 acres. A change in the point of diversion for the irrigation of 43.0 acres was approved by orders of the State Engineer entered April 12, 1963 and March 15, 1965. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and to correct the certificate recorded at page 32399, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly describe the quantity of water and supersedes the certificates heretofore issued to Wm. J. Galbraith.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
