CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **LEONARD & MARILYN CARLSON**
of **Monument**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
North Fork John Day River

a tributary of **John Day River** for the purpose of
irrigation of 37.8 acres

under Permit No. **23868** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **September 30, 1955**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.48 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.,**
2450 feet North and 20 feet East from SW Corner, Section 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fourtieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **5 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

7.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
10.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2
13.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
6.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
T. 9 S., R. 27 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered January 11, 1966, and together with the
certificate recorded at page 33018, Volume 25, supersedes certificate of water
right heretofore issued to Leo L. and Clara C. Flower and recorded at page 29969,
Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
