irrigation of 17.8 acres and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of Malheur the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8 , at page 228 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre in any thirty day period prior to June lat, 1.0 acre foot per acre in any thirty day period after June 1st of each year, or 5.0 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-twentieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located in the NE's NW's, Section 28, T. 19 S., R. 36 E., W. M., 120 feet South and 1000 feet West from N's Corner, Section 28.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 17.8 acres NWt SWt Section 33 T. 19 S., R. 36 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 30, 1970, and together with the certificate recorded at page 37392, Volume 29, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to A. F. Masterson, Successor in Interest to Jos. Robertson Estate and recorded at page 7003, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
