that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second

The point of diversion is located in the SET NET, Section 28, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 8.0 acres NW NW 5.0 acres SWt NWt Section 34

11.0 acres NEt NEt 6.0 acres SE' NE' Section 33 T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered January 25, 1973, approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 6.0 acres. The order of the State Engineer entered July 27, 1973 canceled the right for the use of water for placer mining. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to A. H. Quatman and recorded at page 16131, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
