## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JOY C. NEWMAN

of Route 1, Box 290, Jacksonville, State of Oregon 97530, has a right  
to the use of the waters of  
Applegate River  
a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 22.7 acres  
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
JACKSON County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1902

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 28, T. 38 S., R. 3 W.,  
W. M., 530 feet North and 90 feet East from W $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 28.  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

12.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
10.0 acres E $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 29  
T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an  
order of the State Engineer entered January 25, 1973, and supersedes certificate of  
water right issued to Bessie Smith and recorded at page 32904, Volume 24, State  
Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described.
