of Route 3, Box 117, Lebanon , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hamilton Creek

a tributary of South Santiam River irrigation of 14.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22297 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 27, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEZ SEZ, Section 25, T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 250 feet South and 2300 feet East from the Center of Section 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

14.6 acres NHZ SEZ

Section 25 T. 12 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to Granford G. and Bernice L. Burrell and recorded at page 21344, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 26.1 acres. The right to the use of water appurtenant to 11.5 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered March 30, 1972. Subsequently, a change in point of diversion for the remaining 14.6 acres was approved by order of the State Engineer entered June 30, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right and change in point of diversion and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Granford G. and Bernice L. Burrell and recorded at page 21344, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
