under Permit No. 32945 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Orezon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 25, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.01 cubic foot per second for irrigation.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SWL, Section 22, T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M.; 980 feet South and 1150 feet West from center Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.1 acre NE' SW' 0.1 acre SE' SW'

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
