of BOB K. COMBS, State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right 97305 use of the waters of 9992 Saratoga Drive, NE, Salem Oregon

a well & tributary of for the purpose of

Scism Creek (Pudding River)

irrigation of 43.3 acres of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. G-3052 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

January 3, 1966; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.47 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

NW 1/4 Sec 2, as projected within Hall DLC 57, Section 18, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the water and sewer right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

one-eightieth or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 12.6 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
 - 24.5 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
 - 6.2 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
- All as projected within Hall DLC 57
Section 18
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
