CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RONALD SINGLER

97457

of Route 1, Box 324, Myrtle Creek, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use of one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden

under Permit No. 33557 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 8, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Briggs DLC 45, Section 20, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.; 70 feet North and 950 feet East from NW corner Preston DLC 44.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

as projected within Preston DLC 44

T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
