CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM S. VIAN

of Idleld Route, Box 489, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Deer Creek, two unnamed streams, two springs, and reservoir constructed under Application number R-41383, Permit number R-4647

a tributary of Deer Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 7.5 acres and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 30750 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1965 for creek, streams, and reservoir, November 30, 1965 for springs.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 cubic foot per second from North Fork Deer Creek, 0.03 cubic foot per second from West unnamed stream and 0.01 cubic foot per second from East unnamed stream and reservoir for irrigation and 0.01 cubic foot * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the North Fork Deer Creek - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Willis DLC 45, Section 20, East unnamed stream, reservoir, and springs - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, West unnamed stream - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 27 S., R. 4 W., W. M., **

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit number R-4647,

*per second from two springs for domestic.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
