CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify MARGARET W. BLACKBURN, CLYDE C. LOVE, HELEN
 JEROME LOVE AND GUY W. WERNON LOVE
 of Keating, Oregon, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
 the waters of Powder River, a tributary of Snake River
 for the purpose of the irrigation of 1103.27 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
 Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6 at page 291;
 that the majority of the right, thereby confirmed dates from December 7, 1880 for Tract
 No. 1 of 856.27 acres, 1888 for supplemental supply through the Duncan Ditch
 for 777.27 acres of Tract No. 1 and 1888 for Tract No. 2 of 247 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $1/40$ of one cubic foot
 per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
 contained in said decrees.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
 tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
 Tract No. 1: 38 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter;
 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 25 acres in the Southeast
 quarter of Northeast quarter; 22.2 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter; 19.07 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 38 acres in
 the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter
 of Northwest quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter;
 9 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 10 acres in the Southwest
 quarter of Southwest quarter; 32 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest
 quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in the
 Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of
 Southeast quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of
 Section Twelve; Township Eight South, Range Forty-one: 6 acres in the South-
 west quarter of Northwest quarter; 2 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest
 quarter; 30 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the
 Northwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of
 Southwest quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter; 4 acres
 in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 34 acres in the Southwest quarter
 of Southeast quarter of Section Seven; 15 acres in the Southwest quarter of North-
 west quarter of Section Seventeen; 12 acres in the Northeast quarter of North-
 east quarter; 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres
 in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter; 40 acres in the Northeast quarter
 of Northwest quarter and 40 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter
 of Section Eighteen, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two, All East of Willamette
 Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

Tract No. 2: 37 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter and 14
 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twelve, Township
Eight South, Range Forty-one; 30 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest
 quarter; 32 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; 37 acres in the
 Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 3 acres in the Northeast quarter of
 Southwest quarter; 35 acres in the Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 4 acres
 in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter and 20 acres in the Southeast
 quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seven; 23 acres in the Southwest quarter of
 Northwest quarter of Section Seventeen and 7 acres in the Northeast quarter of
 Northeast quarter of Section Eighteen, Township Eight South, Range Forty-two, all
 East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
