that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.50 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWE NEE, as projected within Servant DLC 94. Section 29, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1840 feet South and 3270 feet East from NW Corner, Servant DLC 94.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,
