CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **STAYTON CANNING CO., CO-OP**
97383

of **Stayton**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Well No. 2**

a tributary of **Little Pudding River** for the purpose of **industrial use in cannery**

under Permit No. **G-4423** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 2, 1968**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **2.67 cubic feet per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW 1/4 SE 1/4**, as projected within **Martel DLC 65, Section 8, T. 6 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 2984 feet South 71 degrees 34 minutes East from re-entrant Corner, West Line Augustus Lambert DLC 61.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
