10310 Sunnyview Road NE, , has made proof Salem , State of Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit number R-4139

Pudding River a tributary of irrigation of 15.4 acres

for the purpose of

30961 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby October 8, 1965 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW NEZ, as projected within Dunbar DLC 48, Section 19, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 1630 feet East and 30 feet South from NW Corner, Dunbar DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any oth. right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to cne-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 21 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 8.0 acres SWt NEt 0.1 acre SEt NEt 0.9 acre NEt SEt 6.4 acres NW SEk All as projected within Dunbar DLC 48 Section 19 T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
