of Box 514, Pendleton , State of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lookingglass Creek and reservoir constructed under Application number R-48722, Permit number R-5710 a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of recreation

under Permit No. 35512 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 24, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX SEX, Section 32, T. 4 N., R. 38 E., W. M., 1912 feet North and 536 feet West from SE Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
