that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes =aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWk SWk, as projected within Burnett DLC 66, Section 9, T. 4 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 2260 feet South and 430 feet West from NE Corner, Burnett DLC 66.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
