**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That JOHN KROO**

of **Route 1, Box 123-A, Newberg**, State of **Oregon**, **97132**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **an unnamed spring and Skelton Spring**

a tributary of **Chehalem Creek** for the purpose of **domestic use for two families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre in area and stock** under Permit No. **35954** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **February 12, 1971 for the unnamed spring** **August 2, 1971 for Skelton Spring**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use from unnamed spring, 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic, and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock from Skelton Spring**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the **unnamed spring - SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Skelton Spring - SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 31, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M., unnamed spring - 660 feet North and 700 feet West, Skelton Spring - 1080 feet North and 2710 feet West, both from S $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 31.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
