CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That N. B. BOWMAN ESTATE

of North Powder, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Wolf Creek and Little Creek, tributaries of Powder River
for the purpose of the irrigation of 160 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 6, at page 291;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886 for 100 acres and 1884
for 60 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot
per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appur-
tenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
40 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in the North-
west quarter of Southeast quarter; 40 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast
quarter and 40 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section
Eight, Township Six South, Range Thirty-nine East of Willamette Meridian, in
Union County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
