CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Charles S. Bowman

of Route 1, Box 119, Independence, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of South Fork Ash Creek for the purpose of stock drinking directly from the source and is limited not to exceed 164 head and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 216; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall ~~not exceed~~ be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 30 of said Decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of Gabriel Hardison and wife, Notification No. 2444, Claim No. 73, Township Eight South, Range Five West of the Willamette Meridian, and Claim No. 43, Township Nine South, Range Five West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence South 89° 45' East 55.00 chains, thence South 20.00 chains, thence North 89° 45' West 55 chains, and thence North 20.00 chains to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
