CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That K. A. Bursell by Phillip E. Bursell, Agent

of Route 3, Box 113, Dallas, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring for Tract 1; unnamed stream for Tract 2; unnamed stream for Tract 3 a tributary of Middle Fork Ash Creek for the purpose of domestic use of one family (Tract 1); stock drinking directly from the source* and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 216; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from December 31, 1888

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from spring for domestic; and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 30 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Campbell DLC 64, Section 15, T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W.M.
Spring located: 2290 feet North and 1940 feet West from the Southeast corner Campbell DLC 64.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
