## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** W. Landon Regele and Thelma R. Regele

of Route 3, Box 99, Dallas, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of unnamed stream (Middle Fork Ash Creek) for the purpose of domestic use of one family including 0.2 acre lawn and garden; stock use and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 216; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock use.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Whiteacre DLC 65, Section 11, T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W. M.  
Spring located: 50 feet South and 50 feet East from the NW corner, Whiteacre DLC 65.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Whiteacre DLC 65  
Section 11  
T. 8 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows:  
Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Benjamin F. Whitaker Donation Land Claim No. 65, in Section 11, Township 8 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence South 27.09 chains to an oak stake on the North boundary line of a forty foot roadway which a 10 inch apple tree bears South 4 degrees West 234 links; thence East 19.62 chains along the North boundary line of said roadway to an oak stake; thence North 27.09 chains to a three inch oak stake on fence line from which a 12 inch oak bears 88 degrees West 31 links; thence West 19.62 chains to the place of beginning, being part of the said Benjamin F. Whitaker Donation Land Claim No. 65, containing fifty-three and one-half (53 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) acres, more or less.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
