CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **Willamette Industries, Inc.,** By **Max E. Ross**
Engineer and Agent

of **1002 Executive Building, Portland**, State of **Oregon**, has a right
to the use of the waters of **North Fork Ash Creek**

a tributary of **Ash Creek** for the purpose of
maintenance of log pond and storage in log pond
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume **17**, at page **216**; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from **1905**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per**
second for maintenance and 18.5 acre feet for storage.

The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$** as projected within **Lewis DLC 67, Section**
33, T. 7 S., R. 5 W., W. M.
Diversion point located: **2100 feet South and 1100 feet East from NW corner, Lewis**
DLC 67.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
