CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Claude Winegar

of Route 1, Box 83 B, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream

a tributary of South Fork Ash Creek for the purpose of stock drinking directly from the source and is limited not to exceed 25 head and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 216; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 20, 1866

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 30 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the -----

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Being within the tract of land described as follows:
Beginning at a point which is a distance of 24.04 chains North of the SW corner of the Elijah Davidson D.L.C. No. 58 in Tp 8S, R 5 W of the Willamette Meridian, running thence East a distance of 18.55 chains; thence North 8.35 chains; thence West 16.17 chains; thence South 30° 15' West 4.72 chains to the West line of said Davidson D. L. C. No. 58; thence South 4.27 chains to the place of beginning in Polk Co., Ore.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
