## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** Peter Paul Baltran

of Route 1, Box 97, Philomath, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of three springs, 2 unnamed streams and Luckiamute River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of stock drinking directly from the sources and is limited not to exceed 50 head and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall ~~not exceed~~ be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the -----

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
