CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Wilson Bump

of Route 2, Box 84, Monmouth , State of Oregon , has a right to the use of the waters of South Spring for Tract 1 and North Spring for Tract 2

a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of domestic use of one family, including the irrigation of 0.25 acre lawn and garden* and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock use from South Spring, and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 6 (NWz SWz) Section 9, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W.M. South spring located: 20 feet South and 1430 feet West from the Southeast corner Gearhart DLC 56.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appured as as follows:

Tract 1

NW\ SW\ as projected within Gearhart DLC 56 Section 9

Tract 2

NEŁ NWŁ as projected within Gearhart DLC 56 Section 9 Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

*and stock use (Tract 1) and stock drinking directly from the source and is limited not to exceed 60 head (Tract 2).

Being within the tract of land described as follows:
That portion of the following described premises situate in Benton and Polk
Counties, Oregon: Being a part of the John W. Gearhart and wife D. L. C. No.
56 in Sections 8 and 9, Township 10 S. Range 6 West, beginning at a point where
the center line of the present County road leading from Pedee to King's Valley
crosses the South line of said D. L. C. No. 56, running thence West 146.21 rods;
thence North 27 rods thence Easterly 109.85 rods, more or less, to an iron pipe at the
Northwest corner of C. L. Bump's land; thence East 418 feet to the center of the present County Road, thence Northerly following the center of said road 632 feet to a
point 30 feet East of an iron pipe, thence East to the center of the Lucimute River,
thence northerly following the center line of said river to a point where the same
crosses the North boundary line of said D. L. C. No. 56, thence East to the Northeast
corner of said Claim, thence South 40 chains, thence West to the place of beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
