## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That Eva M. Burbank

of Route 2, Box 125, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring for Tract 1 and a spring and two unnamed streams for Tract 2 a tributary of Peedee Creek (Luckiamute River) for the purpose of domestic use of one family including the irrigation of 0.4 acre lawn and garden\* and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1890

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use and shall be further limited to the provisions of Finding No. 61 of said Decree.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  as projected within Gilliam DLC 55, Section 32, T. 9 S., R. 6 W., W.M.  
Spring located: 880 feet North and 2070 feet East from the Southwest corner Gilliam DLC 55.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Tract 1

NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  as projected within Gilliam DLC 55  
Section 32  
Township 9 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Tract 2

NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  as projected within Gilliam DLC 55  
Section 32  
Township 9 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Being within the tract of land described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of Mary Gilliam, Number fifty-five (55), Notification Number 5,154, in Section thirty-three (33), Township Nine (9) South, Range Six (6) West of the Willamette Meridian, in Polk County, State of Oregon, and running thence East 35.00 chains; thence North 18.03 chains; thence West sixty (60) feet; thence North one hundred thirty (130) feet; thence West 34.09 chains; thence South 20.00 chains to the place of beginning, containing 69.78 acres, more or less.

\* (Tract 1); stock drinking directly from the sources and is limited not to exceed 52 head (Tract 2)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
