CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Gracen L. and Jessie O. Bush

of Route 1, Box 76, Philomath, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring and an unnamed stream

a tributary of Luckiamte River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and stock and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1896

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use, 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock use from spring, and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock use from unnamed stream

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ both as projected within Allen DLC 42, Section 29, T. 10 S., R. 6 W., W.M. Spring located: 1140 feet North and 750 feet East; unnamed stream located: 1710 feet North and 1350 feet East, both from Southwest corner Allen DLC 42.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and Stock SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Stock NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 both as projected within Allen DLC 42
 Section 29
 Township 10 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
