## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That E. M. Cates**

of Route 2, Box 196, Monmouth, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and stock and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Polk County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 17, at page 217; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.005 cubic foot per second for stock.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  as projected within Zumwalt DLC 49 Section 26, T. 9 S., R. 6 W., W.M.  
Spring located: 10 feet South and 590 feet East from N $\frac{1}{2}$  corner, Section 26.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
As projected within Zumwalt DLC 49  
Section 26

Stock SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
As projected within Zumwalt DLC 49  
Section 23

Stock NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Stock NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Both as projected within Zumwalt DLC 49  
Section 26  
Township 9 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
